THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF DRYDEN

BY-LAW NUMBER 2022-40

BEING A BY-LAW TO RESCIND CHAPTER 240 – TAXICABS, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF DRYDEN AND TO DEREGULATE TAXICAB OPERATIONS WITHIN THE CITY OF DRYDEN.

- WHEREAS subsection 9. of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, provides that a municipality has the capacity, rights, and powers of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under this or any other Act; and,
- WHEREAS subsection 5 (1) of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, provides that the powers of a municipality shall be exercised by Council; and,
- WHEREAS subsection 5 (3) of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, provides that a municipal power, including a municipality's capacity, rights, powers, and privileges under section 9. shall be exercised by bylaw unless the municipality is specifically authorized to do otherwise; and,
- WHEREAS The Council of The Corporation of The City of Dryden has deemed it advisable and expedient to deregulate the taxicab sector within the City of Dryden.

NOW THEREFORE The Council of The Corporation of The City of Dryden enacts as follows:

- 1. THAT Chapter 240 Taxicabs, of the City of Dryden Municipal Code is hereby rescinded.
- 2. THAT By-laws pertaining to Chapter to 240 Taxicabs, including 2404-96, 2360-95, 2456-96, 2559-98, 2909-2002, 3157-2004, 3299-2005, 3558-2008, 3776-2010, 4263-2014, 4549-2018 and 2022-21 are hereby rescinded.
- 3. THAT this by-law shall come into force and take effect on January 31, 2023.
