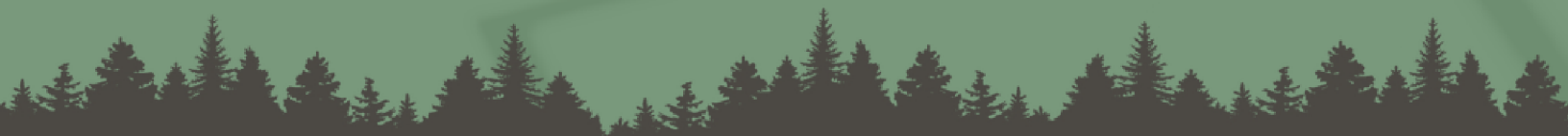

Goals

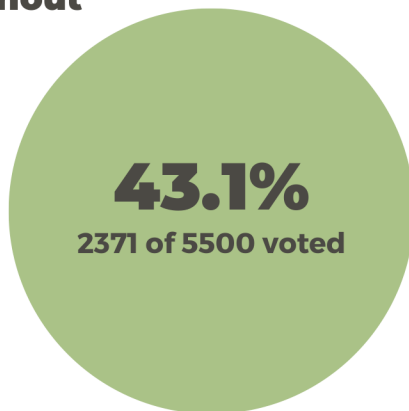
- Deliver an election with integrity, openness, transparency and accountability which stays within budget parameters.

Accessibility Report

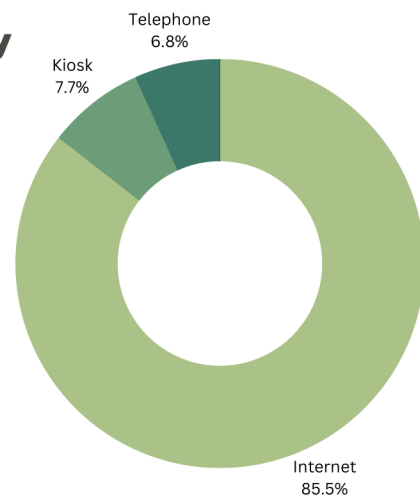
- Utilized online & telephone voting which allowed voters to vote when and where they chose.
- A voting kiosk was placed at City Hall which included accessibility features and allowed for full access for any voters in wheelchairs, scooters, or other mobility devices.
- City staff visited apartment complexes at 330 Van Horne Ave, 10 Victoria Ave, 108 St. Charles St. and the Dryden Go-Getters with a mobile voting kiosk to facilitate voting.
- The online voting solution was fully AODA compliant.

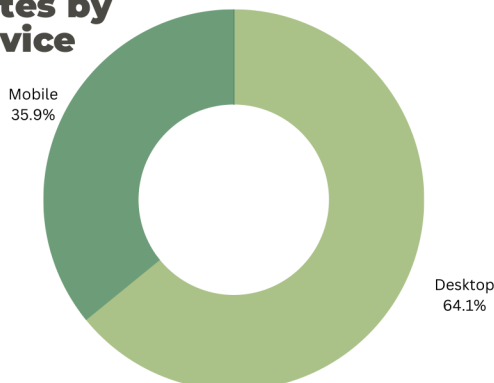
Turnout



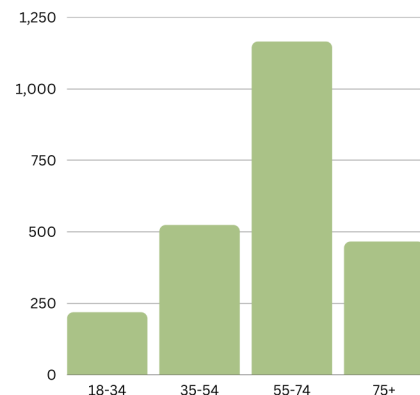
Votes by Channel

Auditing, Security, and Testing

- Extensive testing of online and telephone voting was conducted by the City of Dryden Election Team.
- Minimal suspicious activity was recorded during the election.
- Results were verified and certified by the vendor (Simply Voting).

Voter Engagement & Outreach

- Voting information provided on City's website, Facebook page and local radio.
- Mobile voting kiosk held at Senior Centre and housing complexes.
- Voting kiosk at City Hall during entire voting period including one after hours timeslot.
- Voting website was fully accessible on Dryden Public Library public access computers.

Voter Feedback

- Not being on the Voters' List and not receiving Voter Information Letter.
- No physical ballots.
- Lack of information available about candidates.
