Nov. 28, 2023 - My husband texted our neighbour, asking him to adjust the de-icer so it didn't create open water on our shoreline. Everywhere else on the lake had ice forming to the shore. My husband followed up on Nov. 30 as the pump had not been adjusted yet.

Dec. 2, 2023 - I texted the neighbour asking if she could power off the pump or redirect the pump so that ice can form on our shoreline.

January 7, 2024

After days of very cold weather, my husband attempted to drive the quad on the ice to clear a skating rink.

The quad fell through the ice



January 8, 2024

Large area of open water, notice the snowmobile tracks crossing closeby



January 14, 2024

My husband shovelled off a path in hopes that removing the insulating snow would allow ice to form so we could access the lake safely on ATV or snowmobile



January 20, 2024

After cold snap (-20s), my husband was able to use the shoveled path to go on the snowmobile. Afterward, he walked on the ice to the left side of the snowmobile tracks and his foot went through causing the open water noted in the photo. This was very concerning as my 13 year old son had also used the snowmobile earlier that day.





January 24, 2024

Continued unsafe ice
