  - Effective April 2020 HISA rate down to 1.705% from 2.415%
  - Estimated impact is approx. \$1,400/month, which equates to approx. \$12,600 to year end (assuming no further rate reduction

#### **NWMO**

- Funding Agreement
  - Funding agreement between the City and NWMO ended December 31, 2019.
