The Dryden Public Library Board is a governance Board with the authority to make policy and to govern the library's affairs under the *Public Libraries Act, RSO 1990, c.P.44.* 

Appointees to the Dryden Public Library Board will be an advocate for libraries and library services. You will collaborate to ensure the provision of comprehensive and efficient public library services and make decisions on the future development of plans and policies for the Library. Under the Public Libraries Act, Board applicants must:

- be at least eighteen years of age;
- be a Canadian Citizen;
- be a resident of the City of Dryden; and
- not be employed by the Dryden Public Library Board or by the City of Dryden.
