**Title:** Private Parking Lot Enforcement Agreement

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### **Recommendation:**

**THAT Council authorize the execution of a Private Parking Lot Enforcement Agreement between the City of Dryden and the Keewatin-Patricia District School Board.**

### **Background:**

In March of 2020, the City of Dryden and the Keewatin-Patricia District School Board entered into a one-year Private Parking Lot Enforcement Agreement for the parking lot located at 100 Casimir Avenue. In the fall of 2020, both parties agreed to renew the agreement for an additional year as they were aware of proposed changes to the City's parking regulations and it was determined the one-year extension would provide time for the City to make its changes and that moving forward, a multi-year agreement could be created.

### **Discussion:**

At the end of July 2021 a new Agreement was forwarded to the School Board which has recently been signed and returned. There are relatively few changes between the two Agreements with most falling under the heading "The City hereby agrees" and pertain to the selling of parking permits and to the revenue to be generated from the sales of the permits. The other difference between the Agreements is that the new one has a three (3) year term with an option to renew for a further term of one (1) year after the three (3) years.

**Financial Implications:**

Dependent upon the number of parking permits sold annually. Rates are to be \$150 for 10 months and \$85 for 5 months with the City to retain 15% of the revenue generated.
